Stocking fish in waters of New York State – Section 11-0507, New York Fish & Wildlife Law – “Fish or fish eggs shall not be placed in any waters of the State unless a permit is first obtained from the department, but no permit shall be required to place fish or fish eggs in an aquarium”. Application forms for stocking permit pursuant to this Section or for the Farm Fish Pond License pursuant to Section 11-1911 of the New York State and Wildlife Law, may be obtained by writing to the Regional Supervisor serving your area @
